

Help us shape the new Medical School at Bielefeld University: interprofessional, future-oriented, diverse, and strong in research and teaching

The **Medical School OWL** at Bielefeld University intends to fill at the **Klinikum Lippe** at the Clinic of General and Visceral Surgery a

Professorship for General and Visceral Surgery (W3)

as of **01.07.2024** as an executive position.

At Bielefeld University, an innovative faculty of human medicine with an interdisciplinary individual and population medicine orientation and the University Hospital OWL (UK OWL), with the Klinikum Bielefeld, Evangelisches Klinikum Bethel (EvKB), and Klinikum Lippe as holders, is established. Teaching has begun in the winter semester of 2021/22. We are looking for personalities who want to seize the development situation and its challenges as an opportunity and actively participate in research, teaching, patient care, and organization. We offer an exciting environment that opens up a wide range of possibilities. You will be significantly involved in the further planning and implementation of the model study program in human medicine (according to ÄApprO), as well as in implementing the "clinician" and "advanced clinician scientist" programs and will have the opportunity to apply innovative concepts in teaching and medical education. At the same time, you will play a decisive role in establishing an inter-/ nationally competitive research profile: Medicine for people with disabilities and chronic diseases. The establishment of a corresponding research profile capable of being collaboratively researched is, among other things, a declared goal of the location. The call aims at personalities with a nationally and internationally visible research profile who can represent the field of general and visceral surgery in research, teaching, and patient care in its entirety.

The prerequisites are

- specialist qualification for general and visceral surgery and sub-specialisation for special visceral surgery
- relevant doctorate, and additionally scientific achievements according to § 36 paras. 1; no. 4 HG NRW
- long and broad clinical experience as well as leadership experience
- special experience in in oncological visceral surgery, especially in hepato-biliary and pancreatic surgery
- high-ranking scientific achievements, reflected in corresponding publications and third-party funding
- connectivity to the medical research profile of Bielefeld University
- extensive teaching experience for general and visceral surgery
- experience and active involvement in the gender-sensitive promotion of young talents

Furthermore, expected is a long-term research concept for the development and establishment of projects in the research fields that can actively contribute to the development of the research profile of the Faculty of Medicine "Disability, Participation and Chronic Diseases" as well as "Intelligent Systems, Assistance and Interprofessional Networking". The aim is to establish a research focus that spans the three hospitals and is related to artificial intelligence, particularly within "Imaging and Navigation in Visceral Surgery". This overarching concept is accompanied by the willingness to cooperate closely with the other providers of the UK OWL (Evangelisches Klinikum Bethel and Klinikum Bielefeld) and the professorships for general and visceral surgery there.

As position holder, you will head the Clinic for General and Visceral Surgery at Klinikum Lippe at the Detmold Campus of UK OWL. More than 3.000 inpatients are treated in the clinic annually. Integrated into the visceral surgical oncology is the visceral oncology center of the Klinikum Lippe, which has implemented the idea of interdisciplinarity and partnership cooperation, also with the field of practicing physicians* for almost all tumor entities. Concerning patient care, and as the future position holder in

addition to outstanding clinical expertise, your working method is characterized by a patient-oriented approach, organizational skills, and the assumption of budget responsibility. In addition, you should strengthen the cooperation with other departments, referring physicians, and interprofessional cooperation and represent the clinic convincingly. The range of services offered by the clinic is continuously being developed on an inpatient and outpatient basis and in cross-sector networking.

We expect networking with other UK OWL holders, other faculties of Bielefeld University, and with the medical community in private practice in the region. Accordingly, we are looking for a leader with proven leadership experience and expertise in the entire field and excellent communication and coordination skills.

The Klinikum Lippe would expressly like to invite women to apply. There is a wide range of offers to implement family-friendly working conditions. In addition to our day-care centers, we offer vacation care, reintegration during and after parental leave, placement of day-care workers, and help range in case relatives need care. All possibilities and variants of part-time employment are offered and agreed upon jointly between the doctor and management.

For the appeal applies:

For the performance of the professorship's tasks, generally provided is a private-law employment contract with the university. The teaching load comprises 4 LVS according to § 5 Abs. 3 LVV. The requirements for employment follow § 36 HG. The tasks related to the professorship within health care, including the right to liquidation, will be regulated via a contract for chief physicians with the Klinikum Lippe.

Applications from suitable severely disabled persons and persons with disabilities of equal status are expressly encouraged. Bielefeld University has received several awards for its success in equal opportunities and is certified as a family-friendly university. Among other things, the university pursues a committed equal opportunities policy concerning the appointment of professorships and would expressly like to invite qualified female applicants to apply. Applications are treated by following the State Equality Act. Family times are considered in the context of the selection decision.

The Medical School OWL and the Klinikum Lippe consider equality between women and men to be one main task, and the future jobholder will be involved in its implementation.

Bielefeld University promotes dual-career couples and supports them to create a common place of work and life.

We expect a brief description of your planned gender equality activities, besides, particularly for the promotion of young female scientists and the compatibility of career and family.
