

Help us shape the new Medical School at Bielefeld University: interprofessional, future-oriented, diverse and strong in research and teaching

The Medical School OWL at Bielefeld University intends to fill at the Clinic for Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology of the Klinikum Lippe a

Professorship for Clinical Radiology (W3)

as an executive position at the earliest possible date.

At Bielefeld University, an innovative faculty of human medicine with an interdisciplinary individual and population medicine orientation and the University Hospital OWL (UK OWL), with the Klinikum Bielefeld, Evangelisches Klinikum Bethel (EvKB), and Klinikum Lippe as holders, is established. Teaching is scheduled to begin in the winter semester of 2021/22. We are looking for personalities who want to seize the development situation and its challenges as an opportunity and actively participate in research, teaching, patient care, and organization. We offer an exciting environment that opens up a wide range of opportunities. You will be significantly involved in the further planning and implementation of the model study program in human medicine (according to ÄApprO), as well as in implementing the "clinician" and "advanced clinician scientist" programs, and will have the opportunity to apply innovative concepts in teaching and medical education. At the same time, you will play a decisive role in establishing a nationally and internationally competitive research profile "Medicine for people with disabilities and chronic diseases". The establishment of a corresponding research profile capable of being collaboratively researched is a declared goal of the location. The call aims at personalities with a nationally and internationally visible research profile who can represent the field of radiology in research, teaching, and patient care in its entirety.

The prerequisites are

- long and broad clinical experience
- clinical leadership and management skills as well as team orientation
- high-ranking scientific achievements in diagnostic and interventional radiology with a special focus on digital image processing, reflected in corresponding publications and third-party funding
- Connectivity to the medical research profile described above
- relevant teaching experience for the subject to be represented
- Experience and active involvement in the promotion of young talents
- specialist qualification and further training authorization for radiology
- relevant doctorate and additional scientific achievements according to § 36 para. 1; no. 4 HG NRW

For the University Hospital OWL, a structure is planned that enables the scientific and clinical implementation of the opportunities and challenges of rapidly developing technologies for competitive research, excellent teaching and patient-oriented care. Against this background, we expect the cooperation with relevant areas in the university and the further development of clinical radiology in terms of content and organization – also together with the hospitals involved. We expect active collaboration in the development of cross-faculty and cross-carrier research platforms, especially for linking health research and health care, including translational issues, Experience in bionic radiology, magnetic resonance imaging and/or spectral computed tomography is required.

As the holder of the position, you will head the Clinic for Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology at the Klinikum Lippe. The equipment includes, amongst others, three MRIs (2x 1.5 Tesla and 1x 3 Tesla), three CTs, and one PET-CT. On this basis, you will further develop the existing focal points in clinical care, (including the field of nuclear medicine). In addition to the inpatient area with 30 departments, a comprehensive range of services is covered within the outpatient care (radiology as part of various treatment teams for outpatient specialist care).

We expect networking with other UK OWL holders, other faculties of Bielefeld University, and with the medical community in private practice in the region. Accordingly, we are looking for a leader with proven leadership experience and expertise in the entire field, and excellent communication and coordination skills.

The Klinikum Lippe would expressly like to invite women to apply. There is a wide range of offers to implement family-friendly working conditions. In addition to our day-care centers, we offer vacation care, reintegration during and after parental leave, placement of day-care workers, and help range in case relatives need care. All possibilities and variants of part-time employment are offered and agreed upon jointly between the doctor and management.

For the appeal applies:

For the performance of the professorship's tasks, generally provided is a private-law employment contract with the university. The teaching load comprises 4 LVS according to § 5 Abs. 3 LVV from the start of the study program. The requirements for employment follow § 36 HG. The tasks related to the professorship within health care, including the right to liquidation, will be regulated via a contract for chief physicians with the Klinikum Lippe.

Applications from suitable severely disabled persons and persons with disabilities of equal status are expressly encouraged. Bielefeld University has received several awards for its success in equal opportunities and is certified as a family-friendly university. Among other things, the University pursues a committed equal opportunities policy concerning the appointment of professorships and would expressly like to invite qualified female applicants to apply. Applications are treated in accordance with the State Equality Act. Family times are considered positively in the context of the selection decision.

The Faculty considers equality between women and men to be an important task, and the future jobholder will be involved in its implementation.
