Help us shape the new Medical School at Bielefeld University: interprofessional, futureoriented, diverse and strong in research and teaching

The **Medical School OWL at Bielefeld University** intend to fill at the Children's Center of the University Hospital OWL at the **Campus Bielefeld-Bethel** a

Professorship for Pediatric Pneumology (W2)

at the earliest possible date. Associated with this is the Head Departmental Physician of Pediatric Pneumology and Senior Physician at the University Clinic for Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine at the Bielefeld-Bethel Campus.

At Bielefeld University, an innovative faculty of human medicine with an interdisciplinary individual and population medicine orientation and the University Hospital OWL (UK OWL), with the Klinikum Bielefeld, Evangelisches Klinikum Bethel (EvKB), and Klinikum Lippe as holders, is established. Teaching is scheduled to begin in the winter semester of 2021/22. We are looking for personalities who want to seize the development situation and its challenges as an opportunity and actively participate in research, teaching, patient care, and organization. We offer an exciting environment that opens up a wide range of opportunities. You will be significantly involved in the further planning and implementation of the model study program in human medicine (according to ÄApprO), as well as in implementing the "clinician" and "advanced clinician scientist" programs, and will have the opportunity to apply innovative concepts in teaching and medical education. At the same time, you will play a decisive role in establishing a nationally and internationally competitive research profile "Medicine for people with disabilities and chronic diseases". The establishment of a corresponding research profile capable of being collaboratively researched is a declared goal of the location. The call aims at personalities with a promising nationally and internationally visible research profile who can represent the field to be filled in research, teaching, and patient care in its entirety.

The prerequisites are

- many years of broad clinical experience in the fields of pediatric pneumology and allergology
- clinical leadership and management skills as well as team orientation
- very good scientific achievements, which are reflected by corresponding publications and third-party funding
- many years of experience in planning, managing and conducting clinical studies in these fields
- willingness to contribute to the establishment and future management of the Clinical Study Center, the Pediatric Lung Center, and the Allergy Center at the UK-OWL
- connectivity to the medical research profile
- relevant teaching experience for the subject to be represented
- experience and commitment in the promotion of young scientists
- relevant specialist qualification (pediatrics, pediatric pneumology, and allergology)
- relevant doctorate and the additional scientific achievements according to § 36 para. 1; No. 4 HG NRW

The University Hospital for Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine comprises 120 beds, covers the entire spectrum of pediatrics, and is part of the Bethel Children's Center which with over 200 stationary beds and specialized outpatient divisions, further comprises the clinics for pediatric and

adolescent surgery, child and adolescent psychiatry, the departments for pediatric radiology, pediatric anesthesiology, and the interdisciplinary pediatric emergency room. The Bethel Children's Hospice is under the medical supervision of the University Department of Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine. Within the framework of a structural and development concept, shaped with your participation, clinical research should be organized and implemented for the University Clinic of Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine and the entire faculty. A competitive laboratory infrastructure for laboratory-oriented research and the expansion of central animal husbandry will be realized on the university campus in the coming years.

We expect networking with the other holders of the University Hospital OWL, other faculties of the University of Bielefeld, and the practicing physicians in the region. The position holder is involved in both the development and management of a clinical study center in pediatrics and the pediatric lung center and the allergy center at the University Hospital OWL. According to these tasks, we look for a personality with proven management experience and expertise in the entire specialty and with very good communication and coordination skills.

The EvKB would like to encourage female candidates, in particular, to apply for this position. Through a family-conscious personnel policy, EvKB promotes a viable balance between personal lifestyle and career. Competent support is provided in arranging childcare places.

For the appeal applies:

The tasks related to the context of patient care are regulated by a contract with the EvKB. The teaching load comprises 4 LVS according to § 5 Abs. 3 LVV from the start of the study program. The requirements for employment are in accordance with § 36 HG.

The EvKB ensures that the holder of the professorship is released from tasks in patient care to an appropriate extent and can conduct independent research.

Applications from suitable severely disabled persons and persons with disabilities of equal status are expressly encouraged. Bielefeld University has received several awards for its success in equal opportunities and is certified as a family-friendly university. Among other things, the University pursues a committed equal opportunities policy concerning the appointment of professorships and would expressly like to invite qualified female applicants to apply. Applications are treated in accordance with the State Equality Act. Family times are considered in the context of the selection decision.

We expect a brief description of your planned gender equality activities, besides, particularly for the promotion of young female scientists and the compatibility of career and family.
